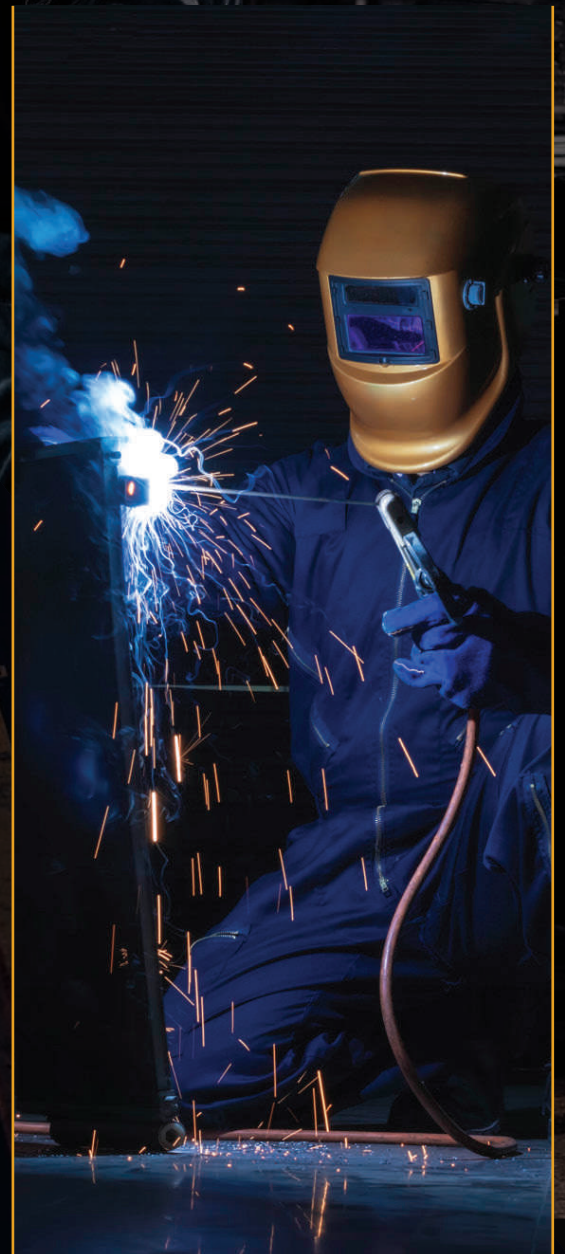

# challenges

## *Before we got on board...*

- Tasnee had already placed an order for Non-FR cotton garments with another company.
- They went through the sizing procedure for all the employees on-ground and proceeded with the order.
- However, Tasnee decided to switch to FR uniforms and canceled their previous order.

*We took up the responsibility in April to deliver the best solution to their requirements with a comparatively tighter schedule. Three major challenges ahead of us were*





## Global Pandemic

*(COVID-19)*

Tasnee placed the order in April and unfortunately pandemic had already hit the entire global supply chains by then.

## Colour Requirement

Tasnee had a very particular colour requirement which was unusual for the FR clothing industry, hence the solution to this problem was unavailable even with the biggest names in the market.



## Employee Sizing

One of the biggest challenges to overcome was the unavailability of the right size chart. Amidst coronavirus, it was impossible for us to physically get the accurate measurements for FR uniforms.

# HOW

did we overcome all challenges and meet the expectations?

## INSIGHTS

Tasnee's decision to switch to FR clothing was the first step towards ensuring their workforce's protection – and that is where we found our common grounds. We wanted to ascertain that even in the state of a pandemic, we stick to our promises: quick delivery of comfortable, stylish and country-specific protective clothing.



## GETTING THE RIGHT SIZE CHART

Since pandemic left us with no option to visit the Tasnee premises and get our own size measurements for the Flame-resistant workwear, it was a rather difficult task to meet their expectations. However, our Manufacturing and Development team took up the challenge and successfully made their own size chart which matched their requirements.





## SOLUTIONS

Before getting into the manufacturing process, we had a few sets of challenges to overcome. It was important to take on them one at a time.



## DEVELOPING THE COLOUR FOR FR CLOTHING

We knew that the garment colour Tasnee wanted was a part of their identity and changing it wouldn't be feasible. Since no one in the market could provide them with the colour they were looking for, we decided to develop one on our own. Our technical team was able to develop the exact colour after a considerable amount of experimentation and sampling process as per their needs and we made a sample shirt within 30 days' time.



## BATTLING COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

Understanding the urgency of time, we wanted to ensure safety of workers at Tasnee, especially amidst coronavirus pandemic. Despite global supply chains being shut and functionings across the industries coming to a halt, we were adamant to deliver the FR clothing to Tasnee in the least possible time. We ran against the tide and successfully developed the colour, prepared the right size chart and delivered the order of over 6000 garments within 4 months.



# RESULTS

Our 4 months of hard work and dedication brought the finest results on the table. Our team of experts developed the colour as required by Tasnee and made a sample shirt in 30 days. The Research and Development department studied the body types in the country and previous orders' sizes to customize HARBOR365's size chart accordingly and ensured delivery of perfect fit and comfort. Usually, new developments could take years but not with HARBOR365. We stood strong to dispatch 6000+ garments in 4 months' time.
